<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No use without customer approval• Avoid certain OS licences?• Agree policy on coding techniques• Shared access to developments• Regular code scanning	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Compliance with OS licences, e.g. attribution• Customer's intended use will not infringe	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Agreed remedies for breach• Exclusion of certain loss categories• Cap• Insurance
